The Chautauqua Sports Hall of Fame is excited to announce that on June 14th, we will be participating in Give Big CHQ! This 24-hour online event, sponsored by the Chautauqua Region Community Foundation, is a great way to get our community excited about giving locally, and an amazing opportunity to raise funds for the CSHOF and 50 other not-for-profits who will be participating.

The CSHOF, currently occupying 4,000 square feet in Downtown Jamestown, has reached an agreement with our landlord to secure an additional 2,000 square feet at no additional cost to the organization. We have a need for additional exhibit space and storage area for our ever-expanding archives, a business office and a meeting room.

A dedicated group of volunteers has just completed the process of patching and painting the walls and replacing damaged ceiling tiles. The next step is to repair the floor and install carpeting.

The cost of the carpet project is \$6600. The Board of Directors has committed to \$5000 and hopes to raise the remaining \$1600 through Give Big CHQ.

The Shults Auto Group will sponsor a \$10,000 hole-in-one prize at the Chautauqua Sports Hall of Fame's first-ever golf tournament, Saturday, June 16, 2018, on the Lake Course at The Chautauqua Golf Club.

An ace on a designated par 3 hole will earn a lucky golfer \$5,000 while the CSHOF will receive an additional \$5,000 courtesy of the Shults Auto Group.

The tourney is open to inductees, members and friends of the CSHOF.
