The Chautauqua Sports Hall of Fame is presenting **The Chuck Bohler Memorial Dice Run and Motorcycle Show** on Sunday, August 10<sup>th</sup>, at the Lakewood Rod & Gun Club.



The event is being held to honor the late Chuck Bohler (left), a 1989 inductee of the Chautauqua Sports Hall of Fame. Bohler was a well-known figure in the sport of motorcycle racing, both nationally and internationally.

The dice run will begin and end at the Lakewood Rod & Gun Club and will include stops at scenic areas throughout Chautauqua County. Registration fees are only \$10 and cash prizes will be awarded.

Following the dice run, riders are encouraged to display their bikes at the Rod & Gun Club along the shore of Chautauqua Lake in a non-competitive motorcycle show. Participants are invited to enjoy the bar and other facilities of the club. A chicken BBQ and music will be available. Raffles will also be held. The public is invited to the motorcycle show free of charge.

Harley-Davidson of Jamestown, Hector's Powersports and Reid's Powersports will have vendor booths displaying their latest products and services.



The highlight of the afternoon will be the unveiling of the Bohler Bike. Dr. Charles Sinatra, a national-caliber restorer of vintage cars and motorcycles, discovered the last motocross bike Bohler raced competitively, a 1973 Greeves. Doc and his crew have painstakingly restored the machine and will reveal their craftsmanship in a tribute to Bohler.

Proceeds from the Chuck Bohler Memorial Dice Run and Motorcycle Show will benefit the Chautauqua Sports Hall of Fame, a 501(C)(3) not-for-profit, organized in 1981 to honor and preserve the sports legacy of Chautauqua County.



## CHUCK BOEHLER MEMORIAL DICE RUN OFFICIAL RULES AND INFORMATION

The dice run is held in the memory of Chuck Boehler, champion motorcycle racer and 1989 inductee of the Chautauqua Sports Hall of Fame

Participants, riders and passengers, will stop at 5 designated sites and roll 6 dice. The entrant having the highest cumulative score at the completion of the dice run will receive the top cash prize. A cash prize will also be awarded to the lowest cumulative score.

1. All participants are required to register and sign the waiver of liability.
2. Participants must be 21 years of age or older to be eligible to ride in the dice run or to win any prizes or drawings.
3. The event will take place on Sunday, August 10, 2014 at the Lakewood Rod & Gun Club.
4. Participants are encouraged to pre-register at a fee of \$10 for the rider and \$10 for a passenger.
5. Registrations will be accepted on the day of the event at the Lakewood Rod & Gun Club, 8:00-9:00 a.m., at a fee of \$15 for the rider and \$10 for a passenger.
6. Participants will receive a ride card, a door-prize ticket and suggested route map. Course directions are provided, however, participants may choose their own route to travel to the required stops.
7. Participants may begin the dice run at 9:00 a.m. All motorcyclists are encouraged to return by 12:00 p.m. No ride cards will be accepted after 12:30.
8. At each ride stop, the entrants will be required to roll 6 dice, have their roll verified and recorded on their ride card by the judges present. The five locations for the dice rolls are listed below:

- one: Start - Lakewood Rod & Gun Club**  
**two: Erlandson Overview Park, Oak Hill Road, Frewsburg**  
**three: Luensman Overview Park, Thayer Hill Road, Portland**  
**four: I-86 Rest Area, Bemus Point**  
**five: End - Lakewood Rod & Gun Club**

9. Restroom facilities and water are available at each designated stop.
10. An additional roll may be purchased at the end of the ride for \$5 to change one's score. The participant must designate which existing roll will be deleted before making the alternate roll.
11. The entrant having the highest cumulative score at the completion of the dice run will receive the top cash prize. A cash prize will also be awarded to the lowest cumulative score. In the event of tied scores, those involved will roll 6 dice and the highest total will be the winner.
12. Lost ride cards will not be replaced. Illegally altered ride cards will not be accepted. No registration fees will be refunded.
13. The cash prizes will be awarded at 1:30 p.m. Winners must be present.
14. All decisions by the judges are FINAL.

## ADDITIONAL NOTES

Motorcyclists are requested to display their bikes on the lawn of the Lakewood Rod & Gun Club for a lakeside motorcycle show, 12:00-4:00 p.m.

A chicken barbecue is available at your own cost beginning at noon. Participants are invited to use the bar and other amenities of the Club. A disc jockey will provide music. Raffles will be conducted throughout the afternoon.

At 2:00, Dr. Charles Sinatra and crew will unveil their restoration of the last motocross bike Chuck Boehler rode in competition; a 1973 Greeves.

All proceeds from this event will benefit the Chautauqua Sports Hall of Fame, a 501(c)(3) organization dedicated to honoring and preserving the sports history of Chautauqua County.
