The Chautauqua Sports Hall of Fame is excited to announce that on June 13th, we will be participating in Give Big CHQ! This 24-hour online event, sponsored by the Chautauqua Region Community Foundation, is a great way to get our community excited about giving locally, with an amazing opportunity to raise funds for the CSHOF and 90 other not-for-profits who will be participating.

The Chautauqua Sports Hall of Fame 2019 induction class brought the total number of inductees to 200 since the inaugural Class of 1982. We think it makes "cents" to recognize that milestone. The CSHOF has designed a campaign titled "Cents for 200" in which supporters of our mission - to Honor and Preserve the Sports History of Chautauqua County - can donate a nickel, dime or quarter for each of the 200 inductees, meaning gifts of \$10, \$20 or \$50. Major League Baseball – A Look Back Again

Last month's CSHOF newsletter featured an article looking back at the times prior to 1953 when there were only 16 teams. The article also referenced the 10 CSHOF inductees who played in the "biggs" during that era. We were remiss in failing to mention another CSHOF inductee who was also a major leaguer.



John Jachym was a 40% owner of the Washington Senators during the 1950 season. Disagreements with minority owner Clark Griffith caused him to sell his interests in the club. CSHOF inductee Irv Noren was a player for the Senators during Jachym's tenure.

The Shults Auto Group will sponsor a \$10,000 hole-in-one prize at the Chautauqua Sports Hall of Fame's second-ever golf tournament, Saturday, June 15, 2018, on the Lake Course at The Chautauqua Golf Club.

An ace on any of the four designated par 3 holes will earn a lucky golfer \$5,000 while the CSHOF will receive an additional \$5,000 courtesy of the Shults Auto Group.

Stan Marshaus, a 2006 CSHOF inductee, Board Director and former club pro at the Chautauqua course, is chairman of the event. Sam Restivo, a 2017 CSHOF inductee, is vice-chairman.
