be participating.


The Chautauqua Sports Hall of Fame, like many organizations, has been financially impacted by the Covid-19 pandemic. For one example, we were not able to have the annual Induction Banquet in February, the major source of funding for this organization.

Fortunately, because we are an all-volunteer group with no paid employees and because we have been conservative and prudent with our finances, we have fared much better than most not-for-profits.

We did not seek, nor did we receive, any government bailouts. Instead, we are asking for a "shot in the arm" from our inductees, members, and friends.

We are respectfully requesting small donations - just \$10, \$20 or \$30. Although it will be relatively "painless" for you, it will have a healthy "side effect" for the CSHOF.

What would be really great is if you could ask just one other person to make a matching donation to yours. Invite your spouse, child or friend to be a



"booster" of the CSHOF, an organization that has been serving Chautauqua County for 40 years.

There are cash "stretch pool" prizes from the CRCF and the NCCF for organizations that can engage the greatest number of donors – not the most money – but the most donors. For example, instead of donating \$20 yourself, \$10 from you and \$10 from someone else's e-mail address would be most helpful in our efforts to earn bonus funds.

Plus, the members of the CSHOF Board of Directors has also pledged \$500 to match various levels of donor engagement.
